
NEW HORIZON IN KOREAN ARCHITECTURE

Choi Wook received his BA degree in Architecture from the Hong Ik University in Korea in 1985 and a Dottore in Architecture from the School of Architecture in Venice University. Venice, Italy in 1990. He was awarded a Macdowell Colony Fellowshin in the USA in 1998 and Vaparaiso Foundation in Spain in 2004. He established one o one architects in 2000

Cho Jung Goo / Guga Urban Architecture

He earned his master's degree of Architecture in Seoul National University and attended a doctoral course in Tokyo National University. In 2000 he established guga urban architecture. Approaching architecture from 'non-iconic' architecture that is closely related to our lives, guga is doing urban research project 'Wednesday survey' and architectural work. Based on 'Wednesday survey', guga is expanding its research boundary into several area researches and studies; the reports about the historic environment and Hanoks in the area west of Kyongbok Palace (2009), collaboration with the Seoul Museum of History, the project about the areas of Bugahyeon-dong, Seodaemun, Wangsimni (2010), Since the first hanok project 2001, guga has worked on more than 40 hanok projects embracing for modern like style. In 2007 Hanok Hotel Ragung in Kyongju won the first prize of the Korean Wood Architecture Award and Soanjae were awarded with the Seoul Architecture Award

Lim Jae Yong was born in 1961. He received a Bachelor of Architecture degree from Seoul National University and a Master of Architecture degree from the University of Michigan. He then went on to establish O.C.A in Los Angeles, in 1990. Lim returned to Korea in 1996 to establish O.C.A Seoul. He has been teaching design studio at Seoul National University since 2000. Major projects are Kwang Lim Open-air Theater (2005 IAA International Achievement Award), Lim's Cosmo Dental Clinic (2004 KIA Award), Asend (2006 KAA Grand Prize), and Caffe Ora (2009 KAA Award), and HanYu Group building (2010 Seoul Grand Prize).

Kim Dong Jin / L'EAU Design Co.,Ltd.

Kim Dong Jin studies architecture in Hongik, Seoul, and in Ecole d'Architecture de Paris-Belleville, becoming an Architect DPLG. He has worked SAC (Seoul Architects Consultants) INTERNATINAL, LTD, in Seoul, BT Architect & Associates firm in Paris, France, He is the President of L'EAU DESIGN Co., Ltd. Laboratory of Environment Architecture Urbanism, and is a professor of Hongik University. His major works include "Bati- ≥", "Scarlet Terre house", "Ohryu High School Renovation", "Iridescent cloud", "RSM Design Studio-Official Space", "Newyork Gana gallery" and etc. He waa received D&D Awards British Design & Architecture, England in 2003, Art directors club of 82nd annual awards, U.S.A, in 2003, Seoul Metropolitan Government Architecture Awards in 2007, Korea, Awards of Korean Institute of Architects in 2008, 1st Young Architect Awards in 2008

Yoon Woong Won + Kim Jeong Joo / Jegong Architects

Jegong Architects was established by Kim Jeong Joo and Yoon Woong Won in 2001 in Seoul. Jegong Architects wants to embody the process of finding an answer to the guestion "What does doing architecture here now means" in architectural design, Jegong Architects takes any project whether it is accessory design, interior design, public design, landscape design, architecture, or urban planning without distinction. Examples of its works include design of an accessory using a spring from a ballpoint pen; design of a sawdust manure toilet bowl; design of underpasses in Han River; planning of a central green park that adopts urban agriculture in its design for a multi-functional administrative city; planning of a Yongsan park which incorporate a forest as a infrastructure of the park; design of Jeongneung Geunsaeng in search of the definition of commercial building in Seoul; and 'ensemble architecture,' which entails exploration of design methodology for the design competition of Myeongdong Catholic Cathedral.

Jang Yoon Gyoo + Shin Chang Hoon / UnSangDong Architects

Jang Yoon Gyoo graduated with a b.a. and m.a. in architecture from Seoul National University. Presently, he is a professor at the school of architecture in KookMin University, a representative of Gallery JungMiSo and principal of UnSangDong Architects. Shin Chang Hoon graduated in Architecture engineering from YeungNam University and completed the m.a. in Seoul University. He is co-principal of UnSangDong Architects. UnSangDong Architects is the experimental group organized to realize conceptual architecture with these variable possibilities of cultural contents. 2007, UnSangDong Architects received AR Awards from Architectural Review award, and in 2006 received Vanguard Award from Architectural Record that is awarded to innovative architect in the world. In 2001 he was selected one of 40 noteworthy international architects by the japanese journal <10+1>.

Ken Min Sung Jin received his B Arch degree from the University of Southern California School of Architecture (1989), and his M.Arch in Urban Design(MAUD) from the Harvard GSD (1993). Seoul(2010): Hilton Namhae Golf & Spa Resort(2006): GS Xi Gallery(2007): Paju Book City Hermann Haus(2003), Kumgang Ananti Golf & Spa Resort(2008); Asiana Airlines Laolaobay Golf & Spa Resort(2009); and the Anmyeun Island Newtown Master Plan(in design phase) and many more. SKM Architects has won the Presidential Prize by Good Design Awards in 2007, South Korea's Best Resort Award by World Travel Awards in 2008 & 2009, and the "Korea Institute of Architects (KIA) Awards" in 1999

He is interested in breaking the boundaries of architecture by experimenting crashing, fusing, mixing, and so forth_ with various other disciplines. He is open minded about boundaries of architecture. His major works include Rock It Suda, S. Mahal, Mookdong Multi House, Ongdalsam, and Sangsang Museum which was awarded KIA prize for year 2005. His drawings and installations have been exhibited in solo and group format at various museums. He also directs short films related to his architecture with the desire to expand the expressive potential of Architecture.

Kwak Hee Soo / IDMM Architects

Kwak Hee Soo is the CEO of IDMM Architects, a tutor of planning at Hongik University and a adjunct professor in the Department of interior Architecture at Kyungwon University. He focuses his attention of the constant generation of urban phenomena, extract issues that need deciphering and presents them though architecture, exhibitions, columns and criticisms, primary works include Tethys(2007), which provides a realistic solution to the problem of traffic and roof_top house in Gangnam, and 42nd Route house(2008), which transforms a facade facing a state road, and Hangang Guadians(2010). The architect was featured in a commercial for Hyundai card, filmed at Hangang Guadians.

Kim Seung Hoy + Kang Won Phil / Gyeongyeongwichi

Kim Seung Hoy studied architecture at the college and graduate school of Seoul National University and completed a master's program at the University of Michigan. He has been teaching architecture at Seoul National University since 2003. Kang Won Phil, studied architecture at the college and graduate school of Seoul National University. They opened Gyeongyeongwichi, an architectural firm in 1995 and Their major works include 2Woo School, World Jewelry Museum, Munhakdongne Publishing Group building, Vision building of Ewha Girls'Foreign Language High School, Graduate School of Environmental Studies of Seoul National University, Youngdong Church, and a house in Bangbae-dong. They had an exhibition at the Venice Biennale and also in Tokyo, Berlin, Boston, and other cities of the world. The awards they have garnered include the Korean Architecture award, Korean Institute of Architects award, Architecture award of Seoul City, and Kim Sugeun Culture award.

Yoo Hyun Joon (A.I.A.) is a chair of department at Hongik University School of Architecture, principal architect of Hyun joon Yoo Architects in Seoul, Korea. His work has been selected as one of the Seoul's 15 Architectural Wonders by CNN. he was awarded as the Korean Young Architects Award in 2009. He has been a consultant for many projects, including the remodeling project for the Blue House, South Korea's presidential residence.
